- Resources coming into schools right now were carefully vetted by District Teachers
- **VISION**
 - Materials to support the new curriculum
 - Want to avoid the way text books were used in the past
 - Teachers to view these new books as “Guiding Resources”, “Student Hardcover Resources” versus “Text Books;” not a 1:1 ratio on purpose!

PEARSON MATERIALS overview

- - 3 Teacher eGuides per grade with one licence (cannot login in at the same time if someone uses your login/pwd)
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Two Key Online Components:

- *Access codes are sent with each shipment of books to schools on cardstock found inside box. 1 code for students (all access) plus 1 separate code for 3 teachers per grade)*
 - 1. Teacher eGuide (access to full ebook, with embedded teacher's guides, Line Masters etc)
 - 2. Companion Website (access for both Students & Teachers)


- Teachers & Students will have the same username and password to access online. If codes are misplaced contact: Dawne.

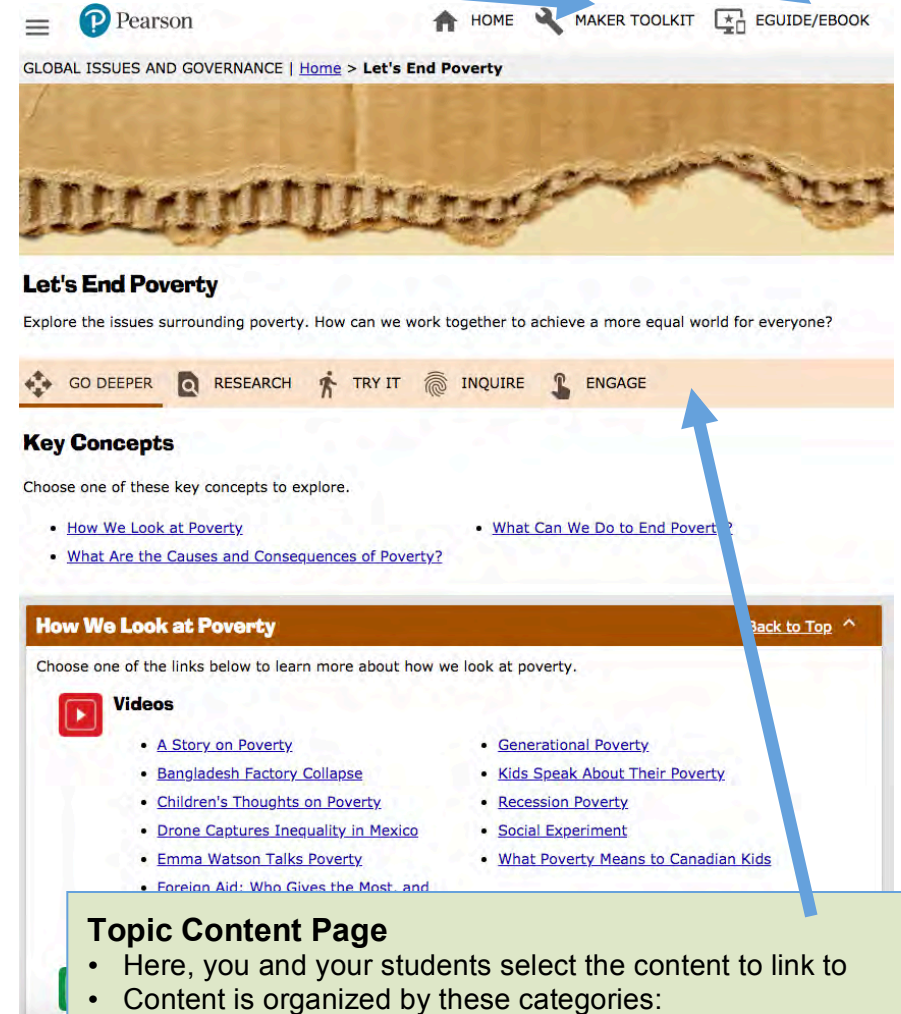
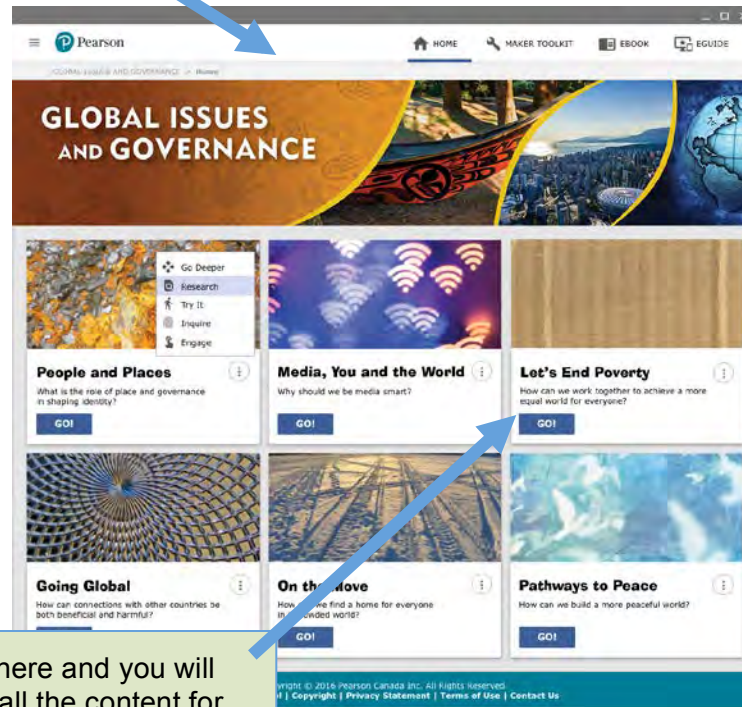
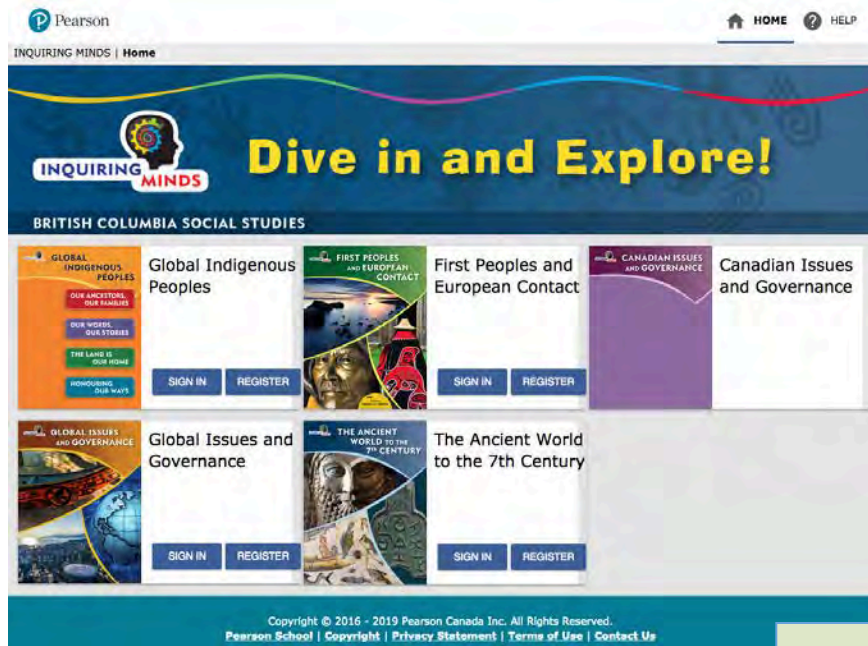
