## Summer 2020 Course Schedule

Mornings-only summer institutes focus on conversational language skills. Full-day summer institutes combine language classes with afternoon cultural activities and workshops. Receive an award of completion (provided your attendance meets the course requirements).

#### **UBC Vancouver**

Three weeks, mornings only, Mon–Fri, July 6–23 (Note: this course ends Thu, July 23); 9am–12:30pm. \$730 to May 29; \$770 after.

Three weeks, full day, Mon-Fri, July 6–23 (Note: this course ends Thu, July 23); 9am–3:30pm. \$1,140 to May 29; \$1,190 after.

One week, full day, Mon-Fri, July 6-10; 9am-3:30pm. \$535 to May 29; \$565 after.

#### **UBC Robson Square:**

One week, full day, Mon-Fri, July 13-17; 9am-3pm. \$535 to May 29; \$565 after.

Two weeks, full day, Mon–Fri, July 13–23 (Note: this course ends Thu, July 23); 9am–3pm. \$835 to May 29; \$880 after.

### **Applying for a Bursary**

UBC Extended Learning supports continuing education for BC teachers with bursaries funded by the Government of Canada and administered on behalf of the French Education Branch of the BC Ministry of Education.

Certified teachers, eligible non-certified teachers and BC school district staff, can apply for bursaries that cover tuition, plus a portion of travel expenses (for teachers outside the Lower Mainland).

We encourage you to apply for a bursary as early as possible. If funds remain after June 26, 2020, bursaries will be offered to applicants who are employees of BC school districts and have regular contact with students in French programs, but who are not certified teachers.
