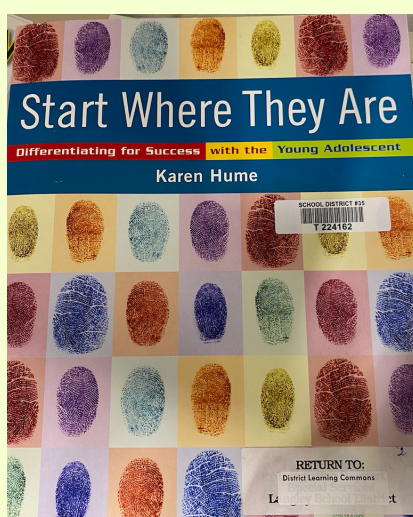
Reeve and Kabot share a wealth of knowledge for teachers educating students with autism spectrum disorders. The visuals are practical, engaging, and functionally relevant.
